

## HOW TO SEARCH THE CATALOGUE BY INSTRUMENTATION?

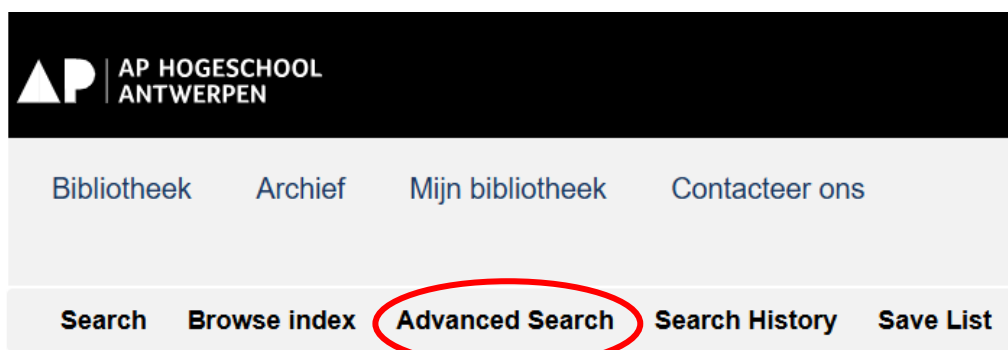
### STEP 1

Go to our catalogus by clicking on the looking glass.



### STEP 2

Select advanced search.



### STEP 3

Enter the instrumentation in the search bar and search in 'all indexes'.

## HOW DO YOU ENTER THE INSTRUMENTATION IN THE SEARCH BAR?

The instrumentation consists of three levels: **NUMBER** : **GROUP** < **DETAIL** >

IMPORTANT! Use the correct abbreviations and order of the instruments (groups) as stated in the tables below.

### 1. **NUMBER: The number of performers: distinguish between the number of instruments and groups (orchestra or choir)**

#### Level 1

- 2 violins, 1 viola, 1 cello, 1 bassoon = 5 instrumenten → notation: 5
- 1 viola, 1 harp, 1 stringorchestra = 2 instruments, 1 group → notation: 2+N
- 1 mixed choir for soprano, alto and bass, 1 organ = 1 instrument, 1 group → notation: 1+N

N stands for orchestra or choir, with multiple orchestras or choirs, you only use 1 N. No number needs to be added.

### 2. **GROUP: The instrument group with the number of instruments behind it**

#### Level 2

ATTENTION! We use dutch spelling!

- 2 violins, 1 viola, 1 cello, 1 bassoon = 4 strings, 1 woodwind → notation: str4 hout1
- 1 violin, 1 harp, 1 stringorchestra = 1 string, 1 plucked, 1 orchestra → notation: str1 tok1, orkest1
- 1 mixed choir for soprano, alto and bass, 1 organ = 1 choir, 1 keyboard → notation: koor1 toets1

### 3. **DETAIL: the number of specific instruments or groups (orchestra or choir)**

#### Level 3

- 2 violins, 1 viola, 1 cello, 1 bassoon → notatie: < vi2 av1 vc1 fa1 >
- 1 violin, 1 harp, 1 stringorchestra → notatie: < vi1 ha1 strijk-1 >
- 1 mixed choir for soprano, alto and bass, 1 organ → notatie: < gemengd-SAB-1 org1 >

For the choir notation, first indicate the type of choir, then the abbreviations for the different singing voices and finally the number of choirs or orchestras.

When you enter the three levels, it will look like this, for example → 5 : str4 hout1 <vi2 av1 vc1 fa1>

The instrumentation therefore consists of 2 violins, 1 viola, 1 cello and 1 bassoon.
